If you do have concerns please make sure you talk to us about them. We WILL listen.

We rely on you to make sure your children are healthy when they come into school that is why we are not taking their temperature before they come in - quite apart from the practical problems that involves with over 750 pupils!! However, if any of the children show any signs of ill health we will take their temperature IMMEDIATELY and advise you of the outcome.

If necessary we will isolate that child STRAIGHTAWAY.
