### 1. Legislation and statutory guidance

Governing boards of maintained schools must have an instrument of government which sets out information about how the board is constituted. This requirement is set out in <a href="the School Governance">the School Governance</a> (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012, part 5, regulation 28.

This model instrument of government is based on the model document in the Department for Education's statutory guidance, <u>The Constitution of Governing Bodies of Maintained Schools</u>.

#### 2. Instrument of government

- 1. The name of the school is Catton Grove Primary School
- 2. The school is a Maintained school
- 3. The name of the governing board is 'The governing board of Catton Grove Primary School'
- 4. The governing board shall consist of:
- 5. 3 parent governors
- 6. 1 local authority governor
- 7. 1 staff governor
- 8. 1 headteacher
- 9. 6 co-opted governors
- 10. The total number of governors is 12
- 11. The term of office for all governors is 4 years except for the Head teacher who will be eligible to be a governor whilst in post.
- 12. This instrument of government comes into effect on 03 December 2020 and is a review of the
