# Writing

In English, this half term we will be learning to retell the portal story 'The Scarab Beetle'. Throughout the topic we will recite, innovate and invent our own portal stories focussing on a range of writing tools including: fronted adverbials to tell how, when or where, short sentences to build suspense, sentences of 3 to add description, prepositions and historical details to bring the story alive.

# **Guided Reading**



This term, we will be focusing on 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by CS Lewis The children will continue learning how to become better readers through the use of reading VIPERS. This includes learning how to clarify new vocabulary, finding information in a text, understanding an inference and how to use the text to make predictions about what might happen next.

We will also be celebrating achievements in our Accelerated Reading Program. To help your child progress, please encourage them to read their books as regularly as possible at home. We expect the children to read at home at least 3 times a week. If you need any support with questioning when reading please contact your class teacher for extra support.

#### **Maths**

This half term the children will be revisiting some learning to help catch up with the missed opportunities due to lockdown. We have completed an initial assessment before Easter and using those assessments we will be teaching a range of topics from place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.




We will still have a large focus on children learning their times tables up to  $12 \times 12$  to prepare them for the government' assessment in June. So far, the children have made
